Ford Transmission and Clutch

Taken from March 2, 1931 "Facts Which Every Ford Salesman Should Know

reprint from Modesto Area A's "The Vibrator"

The new Ford car has the standard selective sliding gear shift, with three speeds forward and one reverse, and a single dry plate clutch. The Ford transmission and clutch are of excellent design, quality and worksmanship.

The transmission gears and shafts are of chrome alloy steel. The countershaft is on roller bearings, and roller bearings also are used in the connection where the drive shaft joins the spline shaft. The drive and spline shaft rotate on ball bearings.

The clutch has a cover-plate assembly, which consists of an iron outer driving-plate and a cover-plate in which are mounted twelve pressure springs and six release levers. The springs are in direct action against the pressure-plate and automatically compensate for all wear of the friction facings.

The driven member is composed of a flat steel disc and two friction facings of the moulded type, used because of their long wearing qualities. The outer and inner edges of the clutch disc facing starts to engage first. As the clutch engages when the pedal is released, the spring pressure in the clutch lining surface picks up the load evenly.

Seven ball and roller bearings are used in the Ford transmission and clutch assembly. These anti-friction bearings are much more expensive than the bushings ordinarily used, but they add greatly to noiselessness, smoothness and permanence. Because of Ford volume and production, they can be given in the Ford without increase in price.

The Choke Rod Wins Again






